The COVID-19 outbreak situation at Concordia Place remains stable. We are thankful that to date no residents and no additional staff have tested positive. As previously shared and as confirmed through contact tracing, the risk of spread in the facility is assessed as low.

Out of an abundance of caution, the following measures will continue to remain in place:

- Admissions to the facility are suspended.
- Staff are completing self-screening to see if testing is required.
- All staff who are in contact with residents will continue to wear protective equipment to further prevent any potential transmission between staff members and residents.
- Recreation activities for all residents are being modified and residents will be restricted to their own units.
- Residents who are symptomatic will be isolated from other residents.
- General visits will remain suspended.

Effective September 21, 2020 designated family caregiver visits may resume as follows:

- Designated family caregivers may visit anytime and for any length of time during visiting hours of 10:00am to 6:00pm
- As previously, up to two (2) designated caregivers may be identified by resident/ delegate but **one** (1) may visit at a time
- As previously, designated family visitors will be required to be screened before entry, to sign in and out, to wear masks, and complete frequent hand hygiene.
