In consultation with the WRHA LTC Program, Infection Prevention & Control and the Medical Officer of Health, the outbreak at Concordia Place is declared over as of midnight December 17, 2020. We are very thankful for the support of residents and family members and for the dedication and commitment of our staff as they provide care for our residents.

The visitation plan for **designated family caregivers** announced December 15, 2020 remain in effect:

- Designated family caregivers may visit anytime and for any length of time during visiting hours specified for your unit

1 st Floor	Mon/Wed/Fri/Sun mornings 9:00am to 12:00pm Tues/Thurs/Sat afternoons 1:00pm to 4:00pm
2 nd Floor	Mon/Wed/Fri/Sun afternoons 1:00pm to 4:00pm Tues/Thurs/Sat mornings 9:00am to 12:00pm
3 rd Floor	Mon/Wed/Fri/Sun mornings 9:00am to 12:00pm Tues/Thurs/Sat afternoons 1:00pm to 4:00pm
4 th Floor	Mon/Wed/Fri/Sun afternoons 1:00pm to 4:00pm Tues/Thurs/Sat mornings 9:00am to 12:00pm

- up to two (2) designated caregivers may be identified by resident/delegate but as per level red guidelines, only **one (1)** may visit at a time
- Designated family visitors will be required to be screened before entry, to be signed in and out, to wear masks and eye protection, and complete frequent hand hygiene

In keeping with Level Red Pandemic Response, general visits remain suspended

The facility will also be resuming admissions next week. We will be working with the WRHA Long Term Care Access Centre to ensure a safe transition process for the individuals moving into Concordia Place as well as for all our residents and staff.

Ongoing infection prevention and control strategies in place before the outbreak that will continue include:

- Staff completing self-screening to see if testing is required;
- All staff who are in contact with residents to wear protective equipment to prevent any potential transmission between staff members and residents;
- Resident activities will be restricted to their own units; and
- If residents become symptomatic, they will be isolated from other residents.
