

December 28, 2020 Concordia Place

We received notice today of another health-care worker in Concordia Place who has tested positive for COVID-19. As such Concordia Place remains in outbreak status.

Currently, there are no residents experiencing respiratory symptoms who were in contact with this health care worker.

On advice of the MOH/Medical Director, asymptomatic residents (those who do not have symptoms of COVID-19) may be tested (using collection of nasopharyngeal swabs) in order to monitor the presence of COVID-19 at the site. **At present we have not received this direction.**

If your family member is identified as a close contact or if they are being tested, you will be contacted directly.

We appreciate this is incredibly unsettling news for our residents and their loved ones. Please be assured that we have moved quickly to enact precautions that will prevent any further spread of illness.

The care of our residents' health is our top priority.

To help stop the spread of the illness, the following measures are in place:

- Residents affected are in isolation and are receiving care by staff dedicated to their needs.
- Visitor restrictions remain in place for all indoor visits. Managers may make exceptions for compassionate reasons. Concordia Place will continue to evaluate restrictions according to the appropriate Pandemic Response Level. <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/files/covid-19-pch-visitation-principles.pdf>
- Admissions to the facility remain suspended.
- Staff are self-screening before reporting for work to see if testing is required.
- All staff who are in contact with residents will continue wearing protective equipment to further prevent any potential transmission between staff members and residents.
- Communal meals and recreation activities for all residents have been modified. If a resident becomes symptomatic, they will be isolated from other residents. Those dining together will be physically distanced from one another at meal times.
